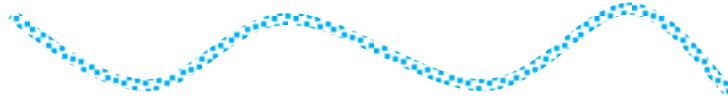


Fertilizer



Read your Soil Test:

Are your P and K Low, Medium, or High?

LOW

MEDIUM

HIGH

Add 1.5# P or K/1000 sqft

Add 1.1# P or K/1000 sqft

Add .75# P or K/1000 sqft

How much P and K are in your fertilizer?

N-P-K

Mountain Pride Fertilizer is 3-4-3, meaning it contains 3% nitrogen, 4% phosphorous, 3% Potash (potassium); it also contains 10% calcium

How much Mountain Pride Fertilizer to add to a 100 sqft Garden Bed?

Add 3.75#/100 sqft

Add 2.8#/100 sqft

Add 1.9#/100 sqft

Add 5#/100 sqft

Add 3.75#/100 sqft

Add 2.5#/100 sqft

How much Fertilizer do I need for my entire garden?

How many square feet is your total planting space? Divide by 100 and multiply by the recommendation above. If your P and K results advise different amounts, choose the smaller of the two, and use additional P-only or K-only fertilizer. If your soil test says Very High for P, K, or Calcium, do not use Mountain Pride fertilizer. When spreading fertilizer, use a coffee can to distribute it evenly in the growing area prior to tilling, and avoid fertilizing your paths.
