Benefits of Serving with AmeriCorps

AmeriCorps members receive a living allowance (pre-tax) twice a month throughout their service term and a Segal Education Award upon completion of service. The Segal Education Award can be used to pay down existing student debt or on future educational expenses. Members also receive student loan deferment, professional development training, and, if eligible, health care benefits and childcare assistance.

TUITION WAIVERS AVAILABLE!

AmeriCorps members who complete a term(s) of service (totaling at least 600 hours) in West Virginia may be eligible for a tuition waiver to WV state institutions of higher learning! To be eligible, students must be accepted to a WV state institution of higher learning and complete the FAFSA. Students must accept federal and state aid offers (i.e., grants and scholarships, not loans or work-study agreements). AmeriCorps tuition waivers are applied after all state and federal student aid.

full year term (1700 hours)	early September - late August	\$825 2x monthly	\$7,395.00	one full year term = two semester tuition waiver
